
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Davis Training Facility Lead Remediation project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Los Angeles, located at 200 N Main Street Suite 1500, Los Angeles, CA 90012. The funding would be used to make upgrades to the law enforcement training center and ensure the existing systems meet safety and health requirements. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will extend the useful life of this law enforcement training center by thirty years and ensure instructors, students, and the surrounding community are not exposed to any hazardous waste materials.
